

## Alumnae Collaboration Ideas

Chapter Name	Description of Event
Alpha Gamma	Alumnae/Active Yard Sale held at our local Speech and Hearing Center.
Beta Gamma	Six alumnae came and volunteered to be judges for Fratman.
Delta Alpha	Some of our members participated in the Miss Flame Fantasy event that our alumnae chapter coordinates. We also made a donation to help fund their event.
Delta Delta	Turtle Race 2007! Alumnae bought groceries, brought in various items that were needed for the BBQ, and they came to the event to support the chapter! Some of them made signs to show their support and bought Turtle Race T-shirts! Also, alumnae worked the grill and helped with other food preparation since most of the chapter were participating in field events.
Delta Phi	Happy Hands. Our chapter collected different items, eg., paper towels, batteries, canned food. We then proceeded to give the items to our alumnae chapter and they delivered the items to Happy Hands.
Delta Tau	Our chapter participated in the Mitten Tree with the Northern/Suburban Philadelphia Alumnae Chapter. This is a modification of the Theta Upsilon tradition in which hats, mittens, scarfs, etc. are sent to Indian reservations. Now, instead, they are donated more locally to the children of the Pennsylvania School for the Deaf.
Delta Theta	"A Matter of Taste," which features wine tasting, dinner, silent auction, raffle and the presentation of the annual Houston Area Sorority Alumna of the Year award. This is an organized fundraising and charitable event benefiting the Center for Hearing & Speech and the Nancy Jones Holliman Scholarship. Alumnae also helped donate items to support our garage sale, which benefited our chapter in Frontier Fiesta.
Gamma Chi	We worked with the local alumnae chapter to come up with locations in the Muncie community to place the Hear Now collections box and <i>Sound Beginnings</i> kits.
Iota Rho	Collected canned goods with Chester County Alumnae Chapter.
Kappa Iota	Dayton Alumnae Chapter. We made peanut butter and jelly sandwiches to donate to St. Vincent's which is a homeless shelter in Dayton, Ohio. We decorated 40 blank cards and mailed them out or donating them to a local hospital.

Lambda Kappa	Our alumnae chapter hosted their annual Delta Zeta Marketplace. All girls worked two or more hour shifts selling shopping bags, helping the handicapped, collecting canned goods and donations, as the admissions price. We also had a toiletry drive in which our members brought various items such as toothpaste and deodorant for the alumnae to donate to homeless shelters.
Omicron Alpha	Our local alumnae chapter participated in Bowl-A-Thon by volunteering as teams.
Omicron Nu	Optimist Club. It is a Tri-star basketball event at a local west end school for children who come from low income families. The alumnae and the collegiate members worked together to help plan the event and helped out on the day of the event as well. They helped children get registered, give out gold, silver, and bronze medals for children who won in their age division, monitored children and helped the optimist club members. The alumnae also helped sell tickets for our fundraiser dinner.
Pi Zeta	Working with the Phoenix Valley Alumnae Chapter to help raise funds for our annual Country Thunder Event which supports the Phoenix Children's Hospital and contribute to Delta Zeta scholarships.
Theta	Columbus Delta Zeta alumnae and Theta collegians volunteered at the MidOhio FoodBank. They worked in the reclamation area where they washed, cleaned, and sorted food items donated by grocery stores. The food was placed in the FoodBank warehouse where local food pantries, food kitchens, and churches from over 20 central Ohio counties come for much needed food supplies.
Theta Eta	The alumnae participated in the Delta Zeta Turtle Tug by donating money.
Xi Omicron	We attended Flame Fantasy and sent one of our members to serve as Miss Flame Fantasy. This is an all day casino event held at the Queen Mary in Long Beach, CA.
Xi Phi	The Greater Kansas City Alumnae Chapter helped us with our bake sale to benefit the <i>Sound Beginnings</i> Program by donating baked goods. Alumnae also donated raffle prizes for our Big Man On Campus event.
Xi Psi	We were contacted by the Grand Rapids Alumnae Chapter to raise money for "walk for hearing".
