SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Preferably works in public relations, digital media, social media, marketing or communications.
- Works closely with the State Alumnae Chairman to effectively communicate information from National Headquarters and National Council to local alumnae.
- Develops and executes a marketing plan and curates content to highlight state alumnae information, programs, events and news. Communication methods to be considered include, but are not limited to, state/area newsletters, Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, the Delta Zeta app and other digital media.
- Monitors and creates/maintains any state alumnae or related topic groups in social media platforms.
- Serves as a resource for alumnae chapters and chapter associations to help increase their public relations presence and positive, effective use of social media.
- Supports and assists with projects and initiatives as identified by the State Alumnae Chairman and National Council.
