Using the Logo

Your Hike for Hearing and Speech logo helps everyone recognize our cause, so it's important to keep it looking its best!

- ☑ Use approved logos provided by Delta Zeta Headquarters.
- Keep the logo clear and easy to read.
- ✓ Place it on clean backgrounds.
- On't stretch, skew, change colors, outline, alter elements, add extra graphics or fonts, or place it over busy photos.
- O Don't create new versions or rearrange logo parts.

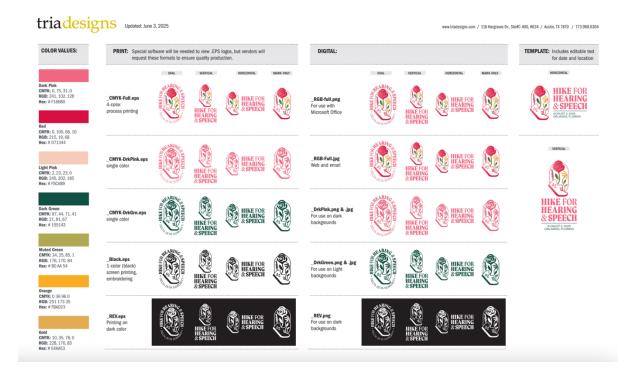
